The Back Alley resumes production this fall with two plays which will perform in repertory-- HOT & COLD and A WOMAN OF INDEPENDENT MEANS.

HOT & COLD follows the same structure as last year's 24 HOURS. HOT & COLD is twelve short plays, each uses a month of the year as its central driving force. It comprises the very best by the members of the Writers Lab at the Back Alley. Over 150 short plays had been in competition for this production.

Elizabeth Forsythe Hailey has turned her best-selling novel, A WOMAN OF INDEPENDENT MEANS, into a play starring Barbara Rush. Norman Cohen directs. A WOMAN OF INDEPENDENT MEANS is playing a limited 14 performances to benefit the Back Alley. The play is in development for a later Los Angeles Equity run, and will not be open to the press at this time.

Both shows will run October 6th - November 20th. Press opening for HOT & COLD is October 15th. HOT & COLD will play Thursdays, Fridays, Saturdays at 8 pm, and Sundays matinees at 3:30 pm. A WOMAN OF INDEPENDENT MEANS will play Saturdays at 3:30 pm and Sundays at 8 pm.
