This letter is to confirm our conversation of April 23 where we agreed to give you the right to do the first act of SONG AND DANCE for seven paid performances, June 6 through June 13, 1987, at The Back Alley Theatre.


It is agreed, however, that in the process of doing so, there will be no advertising, publicity, or feature articles written about the piece, nor, under any circumstances, are critics of any media to be allowed into the performances.

Secondly, the box office of The Back Alley Theatre cannot be opened during normal business hours for public sale. It may be open for distribution of tickets to Back Alley ~~subscribers~~ only, at whatever price the Back Alley wishes to set. *patrons donors 12*


Finally, you shall indemnify and save harmless the undersigned, its affiliates, successors, licensees and assigns and any representatives thereof, against any and all claims and expenses (including without limitation reasonable legal fees and expenses), incurred by any of them by reason of the breach or alleged breach of any warranty, undertaking, representation, agreement or certification made or entered into hereunder by you.
