The Back Alley Theatre extends its critically acclaimed production of THE EARLY GIRL, an expose of seven "working girls" in a Midwestern house of prostitution. The production's run is extended eight weeks and will close November 22nd. The play probes beneath the decadent surface of prostitution and, with admirable candor and lack of sentimentality, offers provocative commentary on the profit motive and the pursuit of being number one.
