How do you know?

NARRATOR

ZOEY

Because I am Zoey.

NARRATOR

Ah. well how do you do
Certainly then Right here and now,
there is a little girl named Zoey
who is four years old

ZOEY

Excuse me

NARRATOR

No excuse me

ZOEY

I am more than four

NARRATOR

More than four?

ZOEY

I am four years. eight months, fifteen days

NARRATOR

How very nice!

ZOEY

-Five hours. three minutes and thirty seconds old.

NARRATOR

For Zoey is very precise
Which means She is very exact about her age,
so we must say exactly how old she was at that exact particular
moment. So Zoey is - my word I have forgotten.

(to the AUDIENCE)

forty-five seconds old. 20EY minutes to

NARRATOR

And she comes home from school, and she sits herself down on her favorite step by the side of the house and there she sits and there she sits and still she sits and what is she doing

ZOEY

WAITING
WAITING FOR SOMETHING TO HAPPEN
SOMETHING PARTICULAR
SOMETHING AMAZING
EXCITING AND NICE
SOMETHING SO WONDERFUL

WHY MUST I SIT AROUND
WAITING
WAITING FOR SOMETHING TO HAPPEN
WHY MUST I SPEND MY LIFE
WAITING FOR MY BROTHER ZACK TO STOP PLAYING
WITH THE ONE TOY THAT I JUST HAVE TO PLAY WITH
WAITING FOR MOMMY TO GET OFF THE PHONE
WAITING FOR DADDY TO FINALLY COME HOME

SO I'M WAITING

I hate waiting Do you hate waiting as much as I do? DO YOU TWIST AND FIDGET
AND FIDGET AND TWIST
WHEN YOU'RE WAITING
DO YOU YAWN? DO YOU STRETCH? DO YOU MAKE A BIG FIST
DO YOU GIGGLE AND SCRATCH AT THAT BITE ON YOUR WRIST
IF YOU DO. THEN YOU MUST FEEL A WHOLE LOT LIKE ME.

WHO IS
WAITING
WAITING FOR SOMETHING TO HAPPEN
I HATE TO WAIT!
I CAN'T WAIT TILL THE MAILMAN DELIVERS THE MAIL
I CAN WAIT TILL I WEIGH TEN POUNDS MORE ON THE SCALE
I CAN'T WAIT TILL I GROW UP TO BE A BIG STAR
OR THE FIRST FEMALE ASTRONAUT TO LIVE ON MARS
TIL I'M ABLE TO WALK CROSS THE STREET ALL ALONE
OR PLAY IN THE PARK AND TO BE ON MY OWN
WHICH WILL BE VERY SOON
BUT I GUESS UNTIL THEN

I'LL KEEP WAITING
WAITING FOR WHAT'S GOING TO HAPPEN
WAITING SO LONG
FOR THE NEXT BIG ADVENTURE TO HAPPEN TO ME
BECAUSE BIG ADVENTURES WILL HAPPEN TO ME.
SOMETHING PARTICULAR
SOMETHING AMAZING
SOMETHING EXCITING AND NICE
ALWAYS HAPPENS TO ME
WAIT AND SEE!

And out comes Zoey's mother who says

(THE NARRATOR becomes the MOTHER)

MOTHER

What are you waiting for?

ZOEY

The chicken-pox.

NARRATOR

ZOEY

Because Cousin Max has it. And I want it.

NARRATOR

Zoey and Max were inseparable. They played together every day. They would sleep over at each other's houses. And whatever Zoey

had. Max wanted. And whatever Max had. Zoey wanted -

ZOEY

Excuse me -

NARRATOR

Yes.

ZOEY

That is all very true. But the real reason I want the chicken pox is:

I AM OLDER THAN MAX
BY EXACTLY FIVE WEEKS AND TWO DAYS AND FIVE MINUTES
I'M OLDER THAN MAX
AND I'M A HALF AN INCH TALLER.
SO I SHOULD GET EVERYTHING FIRST

BUT HE GOT THE CHICKEN POX FIRST
AND HE'LL TELL ME
"I HAVE THE CHICKEN POX
YOU DON'T HAVE CHICKEN POX
ZOEY.YOU DON'T EVEN KNOW WHAT THE CHICKEN POX ARE
SO HA! HA!
Max often says ha ha. when he shouldn't

HA HA IS THE REASON
I'M WAITING
WAITING FOR WHAT'S GOING TO HAPPEN
I CANNOT WAIT
FOR THE NEXT BIG ADVENTURE TO HAPPEN TO BE
BECAUSE BIG ADVENTURES WILL HAPPEN TO ME.
I CANNOT WAIT TILL THAT
SOMETHING EXCITING
SOMETHING AS GREAT
AS THE CHICKENPOX
HAPPENS TO ME

You don't wait here for the chicken pox.

Daddy said I'd been playing with Max So I should expect it. So I am waiting.

NARRATOR
Yes but it doesn't arrive like the mailman
And it doesn't come along with the milkman
And it doesn't come in a box with the groceries.

ZOEY

Well then how does it come. would you tell me please?

NARRATOR

And Mommy said hmmm. and Mommy went whewww But she could only think of grown up words that she knew Like CONTAGIOUS

ZOEY

Bless you. (One always say bless you after one sneezes)

NARRATOR

I just said CONTAGIOUS!

ZOEY

And I said, bless you.

NARRATOR

But I didn't sneeze. Chicken pox is contagious

ZOEY

What does that mean. please?

NARRATOR

It means that you can catch it.

ZOEY

Of course I can catch it.
I can catch anything If you don't throw too hard
Toss me the chickenpox. I can catch it.
If You toss it to me and I'll toss it to you
Will we all have the chickenpox when we are through

NARRATOR

It doesn't work quite that way. But they're a good thing to catch. for after you've caught them you'never can catch them again.

Some say they're like the flowers that come out in the spring. And some Chinese people say the more you have, the stronger you are.

ZOEY

Oh. I want to get them. Please can I get them?

NARRATOR

Of course you can get them - unless you're IMMUNE.

ZOEY

I can't be IMMUNE. I won't be IMMUNE. Mommy. what is IMMUNE?

NARRATOR

It means that no matter how hard the CHICKEN POX bugs tries to get to you.

your own special bugs inside your body stop the CHICKEN POX bugs from coming in.

ZOEY

You mean I have BUGS! Like a fly. or a flea! a mosquito! a gnat!?

And Mommy said. No. they're nothing like that

ZOEY

Then what is it?

NARRATOR

- said Zoey. who was very exact. And also precise. She wanted the fact.

(to the AUDIENCE)

I need some help. I do need some help
I need some children who are willing to be bugs
I need some who can creep
I need some who can glare
I some who can leap
And some who just stand there
Won't you please help me out?

She gets VOLUNTEERS who pass the grimace, glare and stare test.

NOW INSIDE EVERYBODY THERE'S AN ARMY OF BUGS AND THEY WILL GUARD YOU DAY & NIGHT BUT SOMETIMES THEY GET SLEEPY AND THE CHICKENPOX COME IN AND SO YOU GET THE BIG BUG FIGHT.

DON'T ASK ME WHEN. AND DON'T ASK ME HOW THOSE CHICKENPOX BUGS GET IN THE CHICKENPOX BATTLE IS ABOUT TO BEGIN AND LET ME SEE THE BEST BUG WIN

She arranges them in two lines

NOW LET ME SEE THE TWO ARMIES GETTING INTO LINE
LET ME SEE YOU MARCH IN PLACE.
LET ME SEE THE TWO ARMIES
GETTING INTO LINE
PUTTING ON YOUR ANGRY FACE
LET ME SEE HOW YOU HOP
AND LET ME SEE HOW YOU GLARE

AND LET ME SEE YOUR ANGRY FACE
THE CHICKENPOX BATTLE IS ABOUT TO BEGIN
ARE YOU READY FOR THE BIG BUG RACE?

LET ME SEE YOU CREEP....

Everybody has to creep, Simon

Sez style

LET ME SEE YOU HOP.....

Ditto

LET ME SEE YOU LEAP.....

They should leap around the stage, everything but armed combat, maybe who is higher, who can crouch. Oh, choreographer!

LET ME SEE YOU STOP!

THE CHICKENPOX BATTLE IS OVER AND DONE WITH

AND EVERYBODY SURE HAD FUN

THE CHICKENPOX BATTLE IS OVER AND DONE

BUT CAN YOU TELL ME NOW - WHO WON?

ZOEY

Oh please let the chicken pox bugs win.

NARRATOR

I don't know who won. Zoey. It takes about three weeks to find out But if you really want to catch them, Let's go over to and see Cousin Max.

And so they went to Cousin Max's house And they knocked on the door and Max said

MAX (V.O.)

Nobody's here.

NARRATOR 20EY

Then who are you?

MAX(V.O.)

Nobody.

ZOEY

Max. You're not nobody. You're Max And I want to see you. And I brought some friends.

NOBODY'S HOME NOBODY'S HERE CAUSE I WANT NOBODY TO SEE ME COVERED WITH SPOTS DOTTED WITH DOTS CAUSE I WANT NOBODY TO SEE THE

SPOTS IN MY EYES SPOTS IN MY EAR UNDER MY CHIN AND ROUND MY REAR END THAT'S WHY I SAY NOBODY'S HOME ROUND HERE

NOBODY'S HOME NOBODY'S HERE CAUSE I WANT NOBODY TO SEE THE

SPOTS ON MY NOSE BETWEEN MY TOES LOTS ON MY CHEEK MORE ON MY ELBOWS

SPOTS IN MY EAR

AND IN MY EYES THAT'S WHY I SAY PLEASE GO AWAY CAUSE NOBODY'S HOME NOBODY'S HOME ROUND HERE

I LOOK AWFUL EVERYWHERE SO I HAVE COVERED ME UP

I DON'T WANT ANYONE TO SAY HA! HA!

NARRATOR

And now. because Zoey was very grown up, she put on her grown up and serious voice and said,

ZOEY

Max. Open that door.

EVERYONE GETS
THE CHICKEN POX
- EXCEPT FOR THOSE
WHO ARE IMMUNE. IF
YOU GET THEM NOW.
YOU NEVER WILL HAVE THEM AGAIN.

THEY'RE LIKE THE FLOWERS
THAT BLOOM IN SPRING.
THE CHINESE SAY
THE MORE YOU HAVE. THE
STRONGER YOU ARE."
AND NO ONE, NOT ANYONE

MAX

YOU PROMISE. NOT ANYONE

ZOEY & NARRATOR

WE PROMISE. NOT ANYONE

ZOEY

WILL SAY HA! HA!

And Max very slowly opened the door. and out he came.

ZOOEY

"Oh. Max, you look wonderful! want to look just like you."

You have red dots everywhere! I

(alternating w/ May)

MAX

You do?

ZOEY

RED DOT
RED DOT
EVERYWHERE A RED SPOT
I CAN REALLY SPOT EM
RED DOT
RED DOT
LOTS AND LOTS OF
RED SPOTS
BOY, YOU REALLY GOT EM

STICKING ON YOUR EYELID SITCKING ON YOUR CHEEK Cher. STICKING ON YOUR ELBOW ... WISH I HAD A

RED DOT RED DOT EVERYWHERE A RED SPOT. .. WISH I HAD RED DOT TOO.

NARRATOR

And then Zoey had an idea.

Max, where are those red dots you had at your birthday party?

MAX

They're under the ten books and under Egon and the Ghostbusters in the third pile to the left in the corner of my room.

NARRATOR

So Zoey and Max went on a hunting expedition and found the red dots exactly where Max said they were and Zoey put them on her face and on her arms. And she felt much better. She loved how she looked.

ZOEY

"Max, I'm just like you."

NARRATOR

Max looked and said.

MAX

^MZoey. I think you have more than I do. I think I'll add a few more to mine. "

NARRATOR

Max and Zoey went to the mirror.

ZOEY

"Let's pretend, Max. What do you want us to be? 40/

MAX *Creatures from Another Planet, (-Max that on television."

ZOEY

Or Indians.

NARRATOR

Zoey said.

ZOEY

"They have feathers and lots of gunk on their faces."

But no dots. M

NARRATOR

Max shook his head.

ZOEY

We could be special animals -like the ones in the circus that have dots. Mommy, what are those special animals called in the circus that have dots?

NARRATOR

"They are called leopards-" Mommy called from the other room.

ZOEY

We could be leopards.

MAX

We could be clowns!

ZOEY

We could be a whole circus! The Red Dot Circus. Max, let's get everyone to wear the red dots. Barbie and Ken --"

MAX

And Ghostbusters too? *

ZOEV

Oh. yes. And all of our friends.

MAX, ZOEY, and NARRATOR put red dots on everybody, on each other.

MAX, ZOEY, and NARRATOR

LOOK AT WHERE I GOT 'EM! STICKING ON YOUR EYELID SITCKING ON YOUR CHEEK STICKING ON YOUR ELBOW AND LEAVE IT THERE A WEEK

ALL

TEN AND TWENTY RED DOTS THIRTY-ONE AND TWO NOW I GOT MY RED DOTS NOW I GOT MY RED DOTS

TOO!

HOW ABOUT YOU?

NARRATOR

Once upon a time there was a bedtime story that began with an ending.

"And they all lived happily ever after " said Mommy "so Goodnight Max, fais de beaux reves, which means pleasant dreams and I'll see you in the morning." And she gave MAX a kiss, walks out of the room, turns off the light, closes the door

NARRATOR

Max, we have read three.

MAX

But I need just one more, just one more. I'll be your best friend. Please.

NARRATOR

Max, I am tired.

MAX

Triple Please with some sprinkles ..

NARRATOR

All right. Just one more. "Emily and the Ants"

MAX

No, that's only two pages, that's only one minute. Read me Denny the Dinosaur.

NARRATOR

Which was a very big book and would take a long time, so Max settled back, and Mommy started reading

SHE reads very fast and flips the pages. She is not reading the entire text, for sure.

Denny the Dinosaur lived a long time ago in the Mesozoic Age

MAX

When was that?

NARRATOR

A long time ago?

MAX

How long ago?

NARRATOR

Before you were born

Before you were born?

NARRATOR

Yes. 150 million years ago - just before I was born.

"Now Danny was a Brontosaurus and he liked to eat bushes. He liked to eat twigs. And when he got bigger he liked to eat trees. He got up in the morning and brushed his teeth..."

MAX

How many teeth did he have?

NARRATOR

He had 200. And then he went out and he searched for his breakfast and fell down a hole that was called a volcano and his mother kept calling and Danny said here I am, and finally they found him

MAX

Are you reading it all?

NARRATOR

All the best parts...

MAX

I wanted it all

NARRATOR

Well, you know how it ends. Danny's father came down and went into the volcano and got Danny out and they all went home and ate a big dinner of fig trees and palm trees, banana trees and oak trees and lived happily ever after and ever after that and now Good Night and Sweet Dreams - fais de beaux reves. I love you I love you and see you in the morning. And she gives MAX a kiss,

walks out of the room, turns off the light, closing the door Leaving poor MAX all

MAX

alone.
With

Max, you had three glasses of water.

HAX

I know, oh, I know, but I'm THIRRRRSSTY!

Can you hear me? Mommy?

Mommy?

(SOUND OF CLICKING FEET)

NOW I'M HEARING GOOD SOUNDS
I HAVE HEARD BEFORE
MOMMY CLICK CLICKING
ACROSS THE FLOOR
THE DOORKNOB IS TURNING
I KNOW EVERY SQUEAK
THE DOOR FINALLY OPENS
I HEAR MOMMY SPEAK!

NARRATOR

MAX THIS IS IT! NO MORE! Now drink it down quick!

(as the NARRATOR)

Mommy's voice had changed. It was now very definite. And Definite meant this was the end.
And Max had to drink it all
In spite of the fact that he didn't really want it
But he figured he'd better and besides it took longer
And he could hear

MAX

GULP GULP

NARRATOR

and he swallowed and swallowed And he could hear

MAX

GLUG GLUG

NARRATOR

as the water went down And he could hear

MAX

SLURP SLURP

NARRATOR

which meant he was finished And now it was only a matter of seconds And now it was only a matter of time Before Mommy What will she do?

(with the AUDIENCE)

She will walk out of the room, Turn off the light closing the door leaving poor MAX all

MAX

alone!

Mommy! Can I play with Zoey?

NARRATOR

Tomorrow

MAX

Could I wish her goodnight?

NARRATOR

She's already in bed

MAX

Well, can I play with Ryan And maybe Betsy And possibly Brendan

NARRATOR

MAX! GOOD NIGHT!

MAS

Is there anyone here named Mary?

(LET"S SEE IF THERE IS)

Well can I play with Mary
(to BOY in audience)
What is your name?

BOY gives him a name

Well, can I play with ____?

NARRATOR

MAX! GOOD NIGHT!
I am so tired I can hardly keep my eyes open and What does Mommy do?
Not so slowly

(With audience)
She walks out of the room,
she turns off the light
She closes the door
Leaving poor Max all

MAX

alone!

WHAT DO I HEAR
WHEN, I'M HERE ALONE
I HEAR A SQUEAK
AND I HEAR A GROAN
AND I HAVE THIS FEELING
THAT I'M NOT ALONE
CAUSE I DIDN'T SQUEAK
AND I DIDN'T MOAN
AND THERE'S SOMETHING
THAT SOUNDS LIKE A JUNGLE DRUM
IT GOES THUMPETY THUMP
AND THEN THUMPETY THUM
AND WHAT IS IT AFTER
AND WHAT COULD IT BE
ALL THAT I KNOW IS
IT'S AFTER ME

NIGHT NOISES
WHAT DO THEY DO
NIGHT NOISES

NIGHT NOISES

And that's when the pretend part of your mind Starts picturing pictures And that's when MAX heard the horrible sounds That were not the sound of the wind.

Listen!

And he heard a moan and heard a groan 000000000000000000 And he stayed very stiff in the middle of the bed 000000000000000000 And he stayed very still from his toes to his head 000000000000000000 If his arm dangled over in a moment rash They would get at his fingers with a GNAW and a GNASH 00000000000000000000 So he held his arms and he held his breath 000000000000000 And to tell you the truth he was scared to death And the clock was ticking, but oh so slow But the night noises had nowhere to go The night was dark and the dreams were deep When the little boy heard from the depths of his sleeep

MAX

Monsters!
There are monsters under my bed!
If I hang my arm over the side of the bed
They will Gobble my hand
And my arm.
And my head!

MAKE A GREAT BIG GROAN

NIGHT NOISES
THEY RUSTLE AND THEY SHUFFLE AND THEY HUFF AND THEY PUFF
NIGHT NOISES
AND THEY WHISTLE AND THEY WHISPER AND THEY SNIVEL AND THEY SNUFF
NIGHT NOISES
MAKE THIS AWFUL MOAN!

MAX, MAX, MUST JUMP UP ON THE BED LOOKING OUT FOR HIS FEET! LOOKING OUT FOR HIS HEAD! MAX MUST GET TO THE BEDROOM DOOR WHICH MEANS HE MUST CROSS THE BEDROOM FLOOR AND YOU KNOW WHAT IS LYING THERE, ... MAKING A SQUEAK AND MAKING A WOO AND YOU KNOW WHAT THE NIGHT NOISES DO SOHELP ME OUT AND MAKE A WOO AND YOU HELP ME OUT WITH A HEALTHY SQUEAK] AND YOU HELP ME OUT WITH A CRAVLY CREAK AND YOU HELP ME OUT WITH A SLITHER AND SUCH - more find

(AUDIENCE MAKES SOUNDS) YOU'ARE SUCH A GOOD HELP AND THANK YOU MUCH!

JUMP, MAX JUMP AND CLOSE YOUR EYES HOLD YOUR BREATH AND RUN FOR YOUR LIFE HOP FROM THE BED TO THE STEP ON THE FLOOR AND IT'S ONE STEP, NOW AND ONE STEP MORE AND ANOTHER BIG HOP, AND YOU'RE CLOSE TO THE DOOR COME ON, MAX, NOW YOU'VE GOT ONE JUMP TO GO AND DON'T LET THE SLITHER GRAB YOUR TOE

SO IT'S JUMP MAX JUMP AND IT'S THREE AND FOUR AND JUMP MAX ONE JUMP AND YOU'RE OUT THE DOOR

The rest was easy. They didn't dare inhabit the corridor They wouldn't dare inhabit Mommy and Daddy's room. So he ran like a Jack Rabbit right into Mommy's bed And guess what he heard. More NIGHT NOISES. HONK HONK, WHISTLE, WHISTLEE, OINK AND SNORE NIGHT NOISES. HONK HONK, WHISTLE, WHISTLE, OINK AND SNORE NIGHT NOISES -

MAX

Mommy, are you asleep?

NARRATOR

And Mommy said, No, Max. Not anymore MAX And Max said, Mommy I heard things.

NARRATOR

Things? What kind of things?

Night things. All kinds of things. And they scare me. I need a friend.

NARRATOR

Well, they must be very special. Tell me about them Max.

MAX

NIGHT NOISES
THEY WAFFLE AND THEY WOO
NIGHT NOISES
AND THEY SQUEAK A LITTLE TOO
NIGHT NOISES
AND THEY SOUND LIKE THEY RE GOING TO GET ME.

Will they get me?

NARRATOR

Nobody, buy nobody will ever get Max. Why, if anybody tried, we'd send for the police.

MAX

And the firemen?

NARRATOR

And the Firemen.

MAX

And the Mayor?

NARRATOR

And the Mayor

MAK

Even the President.

NARRATOR

Even the President. Everyone, everyone would protect Max.
Now, Let's go back to your bed and we'll lie there together. I
want to listen to your special night noises.

So Mommy and Max went back to his room and they in the bed

MAX

Mommy, can I hold your hand?

MNARRATOR

Of course And it was very very still. I don't hear anything.

Oh, they're there. They are just afraid of you. Because you're a grown up and you're big.

NARRATOR

Well, if they are really strong noises. they would not be afraid of anybody. Let's listen again.

MAX

NIGHT NOISES
WHY DON'T I HEAR YOUR WOOOOO
NIGHT NOISES
OH, WHERE OH WHERE ARE YOUUUUUU?
NIGHT NOISES
WHERE IS YOUR SCARY SOUND?

[AUDIENCE MAKES SOUND] WOOOOOOOOOOOOOO!

There it is? Do you hear it?

NARRATOR

What do you think it is?

MAX

Could It be a Dinosaur
Who cannot find his mommy
And who's just outside the window
And he wants a glass of milk
And so he's crying
Or maybe it's an elephant
Who cannot find his mommy
And he's hungry for a cookie
and I could give him mine.

NARRATOR

Max, did you ever listen to the wind When it whistles through the trees That's what that WOOOOOOOOOO Sounds like to me.

MAX

You think so? I don't remember the wind sounding like that.

NARRATOR

That's because you're too busy during the day to listen to the wind.

MAX

NIGHT NOISES

I'M NOT SO SCARED OF YOU NIGHT NOISES HA! HA! POO! POO! NIGHT NOISES

[SOUND - MOTORCYCLE ENGINE]

Mommy, What's that? It's a Rumble and a Grumble Of Something Who is Hungry And it's hungry for some toes And I THINK it wants mine And it's ...

NARRATOR

A motorcycle.

A motorcyle? I thought it was a monster. - need to tope

NARRATOR

MONSTERS MONSTERS ARE PRETEND. SCARY BUT THEY'RE JUST PRETEND GHOSTS AND GOBLINS DRAGONS, TOO THEY CAN BE AS SCARED AS YOU THEY'RE JUST PRETEND BUT THEY CAN BE YOUR FRIEND

And listen to the Night Noises And what are they like compared to Day Noises

MAX

Day Noises?

Well, what do you hear in the day? What's the first thing?

The first thing is usually Warren. - neld to tape

WARREN IS THE GARBAGE MAN HE DRIVES THE TRUCK EACH DAY WARREN IS THE GARBAGE MAN AND HERE'S WHAT HE LIKES TO SAY SO EARLY IN THE MORNING

HERE'S HOW HE LIKES TO BANG AND SOMETIMES HE LIKES TO TINKLE CLANG, BANG BANG, AND WHANG JUST A LITTLE BIT

CARS BEHIND THE GARBAGE TRUCK HORNS THEY WILL GO BEEP BEEP CAR MOTORS THEY GO GRUMBLE GRUMBLE CAR HORNS THEY GO BEEP-BEEP

I'M NOT ASCARED OF NOISES NOISES I HEAR ALL DAY AND THAT'S BECAUSE THEY LIKE TO PLAY.

NARRATOR

MAX, I know what would be fun.
To put all the Night Noises together
An orchestra of night noises that could play
And guess what Max, and because you really know those night
noises better than anyone You can be the DIRECTOR OF NIGHT
NOISES."

MAX

Is that an important person?

NARRATOR

"Oh, very. I don't know of another DIRECTOR OF NIGHT

Now what have we got?

NARRATOR & MAX

NIGHT NOISES
THEY GO WOOOOO
NIGHT NOISES
THEY GO WOOO WOOO
NIGHT NOISES
THEY ALSO GO HOO-HOO

(IKE AN OWL OR A GHOST OR A GOBLIN)

NIGHT NOISES
THEY WHISPER AND THEY WHISTLE AND THEY SNIVEL AND SNUFF
NIGHT NOISES
THEY WHISPER AND THEY WHISTLE AND THEY SNIVEL AND SNUFF
NIGHT NOISES
MAKE A HAPPY SOUND!

NIGHT NOISES, SQUEAK-SQUEAK-CREAK NIGHT NOISES SQUEAK-SQUEAK-CREAK NIGHT NOISES CREAK - CREAK

(TO AUDIENCE)

What, other noises can we think of?

Fire Engines!

WHINE!

Airplanes!

Brrrrrrr.

Motorcycles

Grumble and Roar

ALL TOGETHER, MAX conducting various units.

NIGHT NOISES
MAKE A HAPPY SOUND!

NARRATOR

And then the NIGHT NOISES Begin to get tired Begin to get slower Begin to get softer And go

NIGHT NOISES
hum-a-hum, hum-a-hum, shooosh wah, shooosh, peep
NIGHT NOISES
hum-a-hum, hum-a-hum, shooosh wah, shooosh, peep
NIGHT NOISES
Look...

Max is fast asleeeeee....pp!
